Event A

Thebes

- ~~Ok w/ own men dying~~
- Father killed 6,000
- Killed 6,000
- Sold 20,000 women & children to become slaves
- Destroyed houses
- 30,000 soldiers
- Slaughtered fleeing
- 6,000 killed for disbelief

Event B

Egypt

- Stole silver & furniture
- Didn't respect Egypt's ways
- Tormented troops
- Claimed he was son of Zeus
- Named city after self
- Brought outsiders to do Egypt's work
- Thinks Greek architecture is superior



Event C

Persia

- You need to suffer
- 30,000 people slaves
- Palace on fire
- Took riches
- Killed 40,000
- Dad hated Persia

India

- 80,000 killed
- Replaced leadership
- Sold women & children
- Killed Brahmins
